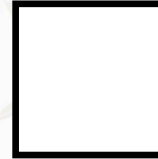

Cotswold Cider Co. Muscle Mary 4.0%
Medium still cider with a blush of Raspberry - very refreshing!

Dorset Nectar Passion Fruit 4.0%
Delicious medium-sweet artisan cider blended with Passion Fruit.

Lyme Bay Reefbreak 4.0%
Medium apple cider with a clean and crisp finish aided by Cherry.

Thistly Cross Strawberry 4.0%
Medium-sweet Apple cider with a punch of fresh, infused Strawberry.

Mr Whitehead's Blackberry 4.0%
A medium-dry Apple cider new to Bexley which has a touch of Blackberry and a maroon colour.

Once upon a Tree Thrown Hat 5.0%
A stunning golden Apple cider of a medium persuasion with ripe apple skin aromas.

Sampford Courtenay Traditional 5.0%
A rich, sweet Apple cider which will delight the palate.

Snail's Bank Appley Dapple 5.2%
A Russet and Bittersweet collaboration that gives a lively, sweet cider.

Beard & Sabre Apple Smuggler 5.5%
A slightly cloudy dry Apple cider with a soft and light tannin finish.

The Ciders

Kentish Pip Craftsman 5.5%
A medium-dry Apple cider, cloudy and fruity but with a hint of bitterness.

Bollhayes Vintage 6.0%
Traditional oak-aged Apple cider with a pleasant medium finish.

Cranborne Chase Farmhouse 6.0%
Another traditional oak-aged Apple cider from Dorset, naturally sweet.

Fosseway Somerset Glory 6.0%
Medium, light and golden Apple cider with a floral bouquet.

Haywood Farm Traditional 6.0%
From Cornwall, a sweet Apple cider made with a centuries-old granite press!

Kentish Pip Vintage 6.0%
A single batch still Apple cider with a mellow finish and medium sweet.

Wilkins Farmhouse 6.0%
Hazy, smooth and oak-matured medium Apple cider which simply delights the palate.

Handmade Cider Fire Starter 6.2%
Wiltshire's entry. With zing and well-rounded refreshment, this medium-dry will satisfy.

Ampleforth Abbey Traditional 6.5%
A Yorkshire Apple cider with a blend of dessert and cooking apples for a medium-dry finish.

Ty Gwyn Festival Ferret 6.5%
Beautiful Monmouthshire golden, still Apple cider. Medium.

Millwhite's Rioja Cask 6.7%
A warming, glowing dry Apple cider which is aged in Rioja casks to give a complex and unique flavour.
